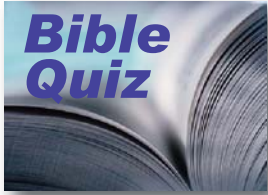


A regional event for Awana, where children in 3rd grade and up, from various Awana clubs, meet to see how well they have learned their Scripture verses and Awana material.

Our Worldwide Adopt-a-Club is just one way that Awana participates in missions. Our Adopt-a-Club allows our children to help children in other countries have an Awana program.



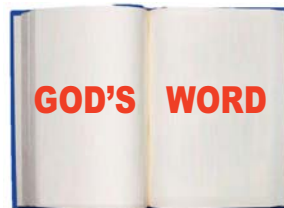

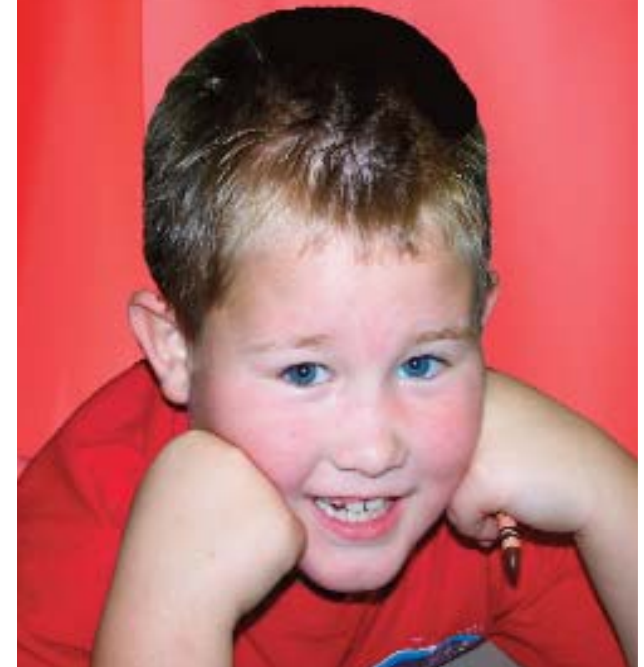
